

DIVISION C - NOW OPEN TO NOVICES ONLY

Entrants must be amateurs who have had no gardening help, other than for lawn mowing.

Novice Classes - open to anyone who has not yet won a prize in any of the Flowers, Vegetables and Fruit Classes in the Claygate Flower & Village Show.

Judges for Division B – D will be: David Burton, Hazel Chant, Norman Ingate, Brian Mathew

- 119 Courgettes - three with stalks
- 120 Vegetable in a pot/container - pot not to exceed 38cm/15in at the top
- 121 Herb in a pot/container - pot not to exceed 19cm/7.5in at the top
- 122 Garden roses in a vase - three cut sprays, one or more kinds
- 123 Indoor house plant, tended by you for at least three months - pot not to exceed 19cm/7.5in at the top
- 124 Flowers in a pot/container - planted by entrant, using your own seedlings or purchased plug plants, no dimension of pot to exceed 38cm/15in
- 125 Peas, any variety - dish of seven pods
- 126 Cut flowers from your garden in a vase, minimum three kinds

The Royal Horticultural Society's BANKSIAN MEDAL will be awarded to the exhibitor who wins the highest amount of prize money in the horticultural sections (Divisions B and C). The competitors who won the BANKSIAN MEDAL in 2016 and 2017 are not eligible to win this medal in 2018.
