Open to amateurs over 16 years only.

All photos must have been taken since the last Claygate Flower & Village Show. Photos may be mounted on *thin* card if wished, but maximum size overall, including mount, must not exceed A4. Entries exceeding this size will be disqualified.

Photos should NOT be framed, as they cannot be hung.

Digital pictures should be from a single picture, not composite, except where indicated.

PLEASE NOTE: All photos will be displayed for you. Please hand your entries, with appropriate entry cards, to an official helper in the photography section of the competition marquee.

- 220 A black & white photo, any subject
- 221 Atmosphere - a photo illustrating mood. Colour or black & white
- 222 A pattern or abstract picture. Colour or black & white
- 223 A portrait (a posed shot of one or more people). Colour or black & white
- 224 People (one or more, not posed). Colour or black & white
- 225 Plants and flowers. Colour or black & white
- 226 Landscapes. Colour or black & white
- 227 Water. Colour
- 228 Animals and birds. Colour
- 229 Holidays. Colour
- 230 Action shot. Colour or black & white
- 231 My best selfie - a print from a mobile phone photo. Colour or black & white
- 232 Buildings and monuments. Colour or black and white
- 233 Photo taken at the 2016 Claygate Flower & Village Show. Colour
- 234 A recognisable scene in Claygate, preferably titled. Colour or black & white
- 235 Photoshop – more than one photo put together using a digital program such as Photoshop to produce a single image
- 236 * Three photos to illustrate a theme – mounted on one piece of card, title on front.
Size of individual photos must not exceed A4.
