## Pre-school

- 280 A sea-themed collage made from natural materials or fabric, buttons, pasta, lentils etc.
- 281 An original painting - mounted on card/sugar paper
- 282 A decorated 'shaker'
- 283 A monster made from salt-dough
- 284 A garden picture made from hand and/or finger prints

## Reception

- 285 Make something out of newspaper
- 286 An original painting - mounted on card/ sugar paper
- 287 An original drawing - mounted on card / sugar paper
- 288 'My house' collage using beads, pasta, lentils, buttons, fabric, sand or shells
  
- 289 A potato print picture

## Years 1 & 2

- 290 A short poem, mounted on card / sugar paper
- 291 Make model of a fantasy creature using recycled materials
- 292 An original drawing - mounted on card / sugar paper
- 293 An original painting - mounted on card / sugar paper
- 294 A picture of your favourite book character, with the character's name shown on the front

## Years 3 & 4

- 295 An original poem - max. 1 side A4, mounted on card / sugar paper
- 296 Create a fantasy landscape in a shoe-box
- 297 An original drawing - mounted on card / sugar paper
- 298 An original painting - mounted on card / sugar paper
- 299 Decorate a pillowcase using a repeating pattern

## Years 5 & 6

- 300 An original poem - max. 1 side A4, mounted on card / sugar paper
- 301 An original drawing - mounted on card /sugar paper
- 302 An original painting - mounted on card /sugar paper
- 303 Make a raft / boat using natural materials
- 304 Create a scene from a play or a book in a shoe-box

## Years 7 - 9

- 305 A piece of computer generated art - mounted on card / sugar paper
- 306 Your best piece of creative writing - max. 1 side A4, mounted on card / sugar paper
- 307 An original picture, painting or drawing - mounted on card /sugar paper
- 308 A design technology, electronics or art project, include the original plan/sketch/design as well as the finished article

## Years 10 - 11

- 309 An original drawing or painting - mounted on card/sugar paper
- 310 A design technology, electronics or art project, include the original plan/sketch/design as well as the finished article

- 311 An upcycled project - a 'new' item of clothing, furniture or other usable object made from recycled materials
- 312 Bake your favourite cake, judged on taste

#### Open - Young photographer, chef, gardener and artist (any age)

- 313 A piece of handicraft ( for example, jewellery, textiles, clay or other materials)
- 314 A photograph of a living subject, human or animal - mounted on card/sugar paper
- 315 A photograph of a landscape or seascape - mounted on card/sugar paper
- 316 Make 3 savoury biscuits with labelled key ingredients
- 317 A miniature garden or allotment
- 318 A decorated welly filled with plants or flowers
- 319 A flower in a pot grown by you
- 320 A painted or glazed ceramic object, e.g. a plate, mug
- 321 Design a poster for next year's Claygate Flower & Village Show.
- The winning entry will be printed within the 2018 programme - see Junior Section photo page for Thomas Skingle's winning entry from last year
- 322 Four decorated cupcakes with a fantasy theme

- 328 Majority of group in Years 7 - 9 (you may also enter an original film or music on memory stick, DVD or CD)
- 329 Majority of group in Years 10 - 11
- 330 Any age - garden produce grown by your group

#### Junior Section: Points, Prizes and Cups

Points awarded: 1<sup>st</sup> = 10 points, 2<sup>nd</sup> = 8 points, 3<sup>rd</sup> = 6 points, Highly Commended = 4 points Prizes: 1st prize £3, 2nd prize £2, 3rd prize £1

- **A cup to keep:** awarded for the most points gained in each division.
- **The Junior Committee Cup:** awarded for best overall contribution, to someone who has not otherwise been awarded a cup or trophy.
- **The Fawcus Cup:** awarded to the school with the most first prizes.
- **The Brian Anscumb Cup:** a commemorative cup for the best exhibit, in the opinion of the judges.
- **Group Work Trophies:** awarded for best in each age range.
- For Pre-school children, sweets and medals will be awarded instead of prize money.
- For group work, certificates can be awarded instead of prize money.

#### Points to Remember

- There are now TWO WAYS YOU CAN ENTER an exhibit:
  - ENTER ONLINE at [claygateflowershow.co.uk](http://claygateflowershow.co.uk) by 6pm on Monday 10<sup>th</sup> July
  - Complete an official entry form to be handed in by 6pm on Monday 10<sup>th</sup> July to Johnston's newsagent, Claygate.

- Your exhibits should be brought to the Junior end of the marquee, between 8.00am and 10.00am on Saturday 15th July.
- Paper exhibits (pictures, photographs, poems etc.) need to be mounted on card or sugar paper so that we can display your work more effectively. They may be laminated.
- Write your name, school and a phone number on the **back** of all exhibits.
- Only one entry allowed per person per Flower Show class.
- Exhibits must not have been entered into the Flower Show in previous years.
- Please resist the urge to help your children too much; the judges do like to see the children's own work.

### **Don't forget**

- All Junior cups will be presented in the Main Arena at 4.15pm. Please make sure that someone is at the arena to collect your cup if you are unable to attend.
- Prizes may be collected from the Junior end of the marquee as soon as we have added up all the points! The winners will be displayed and results also published on the website.
- The Junior exhibition is open for all to enjoy until 5.30pm, when you may return to collect your work. Please **do not** ask to remove your exhibits before this time, as it spoils the display for others and causes difficulties. Any exhibits not collected at the end of the day may (sadly) be thrown away.
